### INAFSM BOARD TREASURER VACANCY

# HB 1096

This proposed legislation was intended to limit the local erosion & sediment control stormwater ordinance requirements that any MS4 could require to be no more stringent than IDEM's Rule 5. Kerry Daily and I attended the state Senate Hearing on HB 1096 where Kerry gave testimony. Before the hearing, I signed a letter on behalf of INAFSM stating our opposition to this draft legislation. We will discuss this more during the Board meeting and will need additional outreach on this issue.
