 - Scheduled for distribution first quarter 2005
 - October 1, 2005 first effective classifications with 2004 Manual
- Possible changes for 2004 (currently still be reviewed by CRSTF)
 - Incorporate All Hazards Approach to various activities (510)
 - Changes to credits for information on web sites
 - Changes to Special Hazards credits
- NEW CRS BROCHURES – reflect DHS – FEMA logo and some editing
 - Brochures in process of being updated and printed
- REVISED MODELS (?) – to reflect any 2004 changes [2002 current editions] [see order form Appendix E in handouts]
- BCEGS REQUIREMENT (Building Code Effectiveness Grading Schedule)
 - ISO revised Schedule that may positively effect some gradings
- NEW ELEVATION CERTIFICATE FORM (May 1, 2005 ?)
 - Photographs attached (not required for CRS communities to keep)
 - Enclosure / Crawlspace Data
 - Format revised
- New ISO Elevation Certificate Software (March 2004)
 - Distribution in April 2004 (needs to be requested)
