## L273 Managing Floodplain Development through the National Flood Insurance Program

### Course Description

This course is designed to provide an organized training opportunity for local officials responsible for administering their local floodplain ordinance. The course will focus on the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and concepts of floodplain management, maps and studies, ordinance administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance. Hands-on exercises are included to allow participants to better apply the information in their communities.



### Selection Criteria

Local officials responsible for administering local floodplain management ordinances, including but not limited to floodplain management administrators, building inspectors, code enforcement/zoning officers, planners, city/county managers, attorneys, engineers, and public works officials. Federal/state/regional floodplain managers also are encouraged to attend. The course is designed for those officials with limited floodplain management experience. This course is excellent preparation for the Certified Floodplain Managers Exam.

The course will be held at the Conference Center (Conference Room A) in Indiana Government Center South Building, 402 W. Washington Street, Indianapolis.
