<b>Position Title:</b>	Stormwater Technician
<b>Position Summary:</b>	Position is responsible for assisting the Stormwater Inspector with all aspects of stormwater permit operations, including stormwater plan review, inspections of construction and logging activities, and management of the post-construction stormwater runoff program. Position assists the Stormwater Specialist with implementation of the County's stormwater quality management plan. Position reports directly to the Stormwater Program Manager.
<b>Qualifications and Duties:</b>	<p>A Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Geology, Environmental Science, Natural Resources, or related field; Must be at least 21 years of age; and Possession of and/or ability to obtain and maintain CESSWI certification within three (3) years of hire.</p> <p>Duties include assisting with the management and administration of Stormwater Permits, conducting reviews of plats, maps, plans, and technical reports, and performing inspections of active construction sites and logging operations. Assisting with Stormwater Program education and outreach. Participating in County climate resilience initiatives. Assisting with storm sewer system mapping. Collecting stormwater samples and performing simple water quality tests.</p>
