Slide 5: Description of what is included in Construction and Demolition (C&D) waste that is allowed in a licensed landfill. A question arose on if asphalt was included in the definition. Ms. Barnes followed-up on this question stating that asphalt is not include in the definition of C&D waste, but that a generator can request special approval from the Commissioner for disposal of materials that are incidental, similar size and type to the list of approved waste, and will not pose a greater risk than the approved wastes. IDEM's landfill section said they do not recall having seen a request for asphalt before and have not seen any at a C&D landfill.

Slide 6: Description of storage practices for stockpiles of waste (e.g. street sweepings, catch basin cleaning debris, etc.) when stored on-site before disposal at a landfill. A question arose concerning the six-month limit on accumulation/storage of the waste. Ms. Barnes explained that if the site shows that it ships the waste when there is a full load and does not intend it for long-term storage, then the six-month limit is not enforced.

Ms. Barnes stated that IDEM is working on fact sheets/guidance for building demolition waste with painted concrete and tire disposal.
