

2011 Annual Conference Highlights (cont.)

ATTENDANCE

Registrants at the Conference totaled 180 and consisted of local, county, state, and regional government officials, as well as numerous consultants and vendors.

State registrants consisted of officials from IDNR (13), IDHS (3), IDEM (2), and USGS (1). Regional registrants consisted of officials from FEMA (4), USDA/NRCS (1), USACOE (1), and USGS (1).



Local and County officials made up 50% of the total registrants and consisted primarily of Local and County MS4s.
